- Date of birth
- Your name
- The year of your birth
- The name of your school



Remember, try not to use the same password for multiple things!

How to be Safe on the Internet

- Make sure not to share any personal information on the Internet such as your full name, address, telephone number, school name, revolut details etc.
- If you get a scary or threatening messages, you should always tell an adult straight away
- Do not click on any emails or pop-ups you are not sure about as they may be fake or scams
- Only use sites that you know are safe (check with your parents / guardian first to be sure)
- \succ Make sure to obey age restrictions where they apply
